

BE A PART OF IT ON SALE DAY

Each prospective buyer will receive a buyer's credential for admission to the fairgrounds. Upon arrival, for your convenience, sale catalogs will be available, listing all animals in order of sale, their weights and the owner's name. Be sure to pick up a buyer's number at the sale desk. As each animal enters the ring, the auctioneer will ask for bids in DOLLARS PER POUND for beef, goats, swine and sheep. Quail, rabbits, chickens and turkeys are sold by the lot (or pen). When a buyer bids on a pen they are bidding on the entire lot/pen. When the animal of your choice enters the ring simply raise your buyer's number. If you need help bidding, ask one of the ring men for assistance. The bidding will continue until the highest bid is reached. The highest bidder gets the animal. Whether or not you buy, your bidding will help the sale. After buying, a runner will present you with an Auction Sales Agreement. At this time, you must indicate the disposition of the animal. Your choices are:

DISPOSITION CHOICES

A. CUSTOM PROCESSING. The animal will be processed, inspected and delivered to one of the butcher shops in the area. You will need to indicate your preference of butcher shops and make arrangements with them for cutting instructions.

Any animal that is left over 60 days at a butcher shop may be disposed of at the discretion of that shop.

If you purchase a custom processed animal, a harvesting fee will be included in your invoice.

OR

B. RESALE. Animals that are bought by individuals who do not desire the meat will be resold at market price. You will be billed for the difference between the market price and your bill.

THERE IS NO LIVE ANIMAL PICKUP

The Solano County Fair will be acting as cashier for the sale and will be set up to accept your payment during and following the sale.

SMALL ANIMALS

Buyers may choose to process small animals if they would like the meat or may choose resale. There is no longer an option for live take or donating back to exhibitors.

CHICKENS

Chickens are sold as a pair.
A fryer will weigh between 3 ½ to 6 pounds and dress out at 2 to 4 pounds.

* 2 Birds = 1 pen at \$350.00 \$350.00

COTOURNIX QUAIL

Quail are sold as a pair.
Quail are 6 to 8 weeks old and weigh less than one pound each.

* 2 Quail = 1 pen at \$150.00. \$150.00
* Process charge..... 10.00

RABBITS

Rabbits are sold as a pen of three and single fryers
Rabbits will weigh from 3 to 6 pounds each and will dress out at 2 to 4 pounds.

* 3 Rabbits = 1 pen at \$200.00 \$300.00
* Process charge..... 30.00
\$330.00

TURKEYS

Turkeys are sold individually.
Turkeys will weigh from 15 to 35 pounds each.

* 1 Turkey at \$150.00 each. \$150.00
* Process charge..... 25.00
\$175.00
