ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY

All entries for the 2024 Solano County Fair will be received online only at [SCFair.com](https://www.scfair.com).

Entry Deadlines:

Market Beef, Goats, Sheep & Swine deadline is May 22, 2024.

Fine Arts, Floriculture, Adult Solano Living Youth Solano Living, Market Poultry, Market Rabbits and Breeding Livestock entry deadline is May 22, 2024.

HELPFUL TIPS

- Read the rules of the department and division that you are entering. Read *Local and State Rules*.
- At the beginning of each department is a listing of eligibility requirements, entry fees and registration deadlines.
- Enter early, don't wait until the last minute.

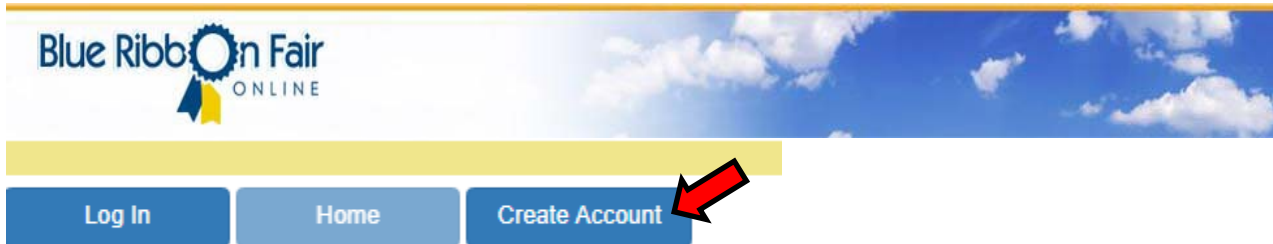
HOW TO ENTER

If this is your first time logging into the Blue Ribbon entry system for 2024, you will need to start by setting up a new online account for this year.

Step 1: Go to the Solano County Fair website scfair.com, open Solano County Fair and select the green “Enter Online Here” button.



Step 2: Create Account from the Blue Ribbon main page. Click on the “Create Account” button.



Step 3: Complete the required information to set-up your account. Once you have filled in the appropriate information, click the “Save Account Information” button. Make sure to write down your user ID/password and keep it in a safe location to reference your account as needed in 2024.

Special instructions for youth exhibitors:

Division: Select the appropriate type of youth exhibitor you are, 4-H, FFA or Open Youth.

Youth that are entering under more than one organization must set-up an account for each organization they plan to represent.

Club Name: Select the organization you represent from the drop down list provided. If you are not entering in 4-H, FFA or Grange; use the organization titled Independent.

Example: Vacaville Independent

YQCA: If you are a livestock exhibitor, please enter your YQCA certificate number here.

Step 8: Enter a description of your item being entered here, then “Save Entry” to complete
